As he approached them, one of the females brandished a knife and both females then exited the store. Suspect #1 is described as a black female in her 20's, 5'8-5'10, 160 lbs., with pink braided hair. She was wearing a facemask, green sweatpants, white Nike sneakers, and a Nike men's windbreaker type jacket. Suspect #2 is described as a black female in her 20's, 5'5, 180 lbs., with black braided hair. She was wearing a black facemask, black Nike hooded sweatshirt, black pants, and black shoes.

		It is believed that the suspects left in a vehicle, which was driven by a third suspect. More information will be released as available. This case remains under investigation. SO200015935

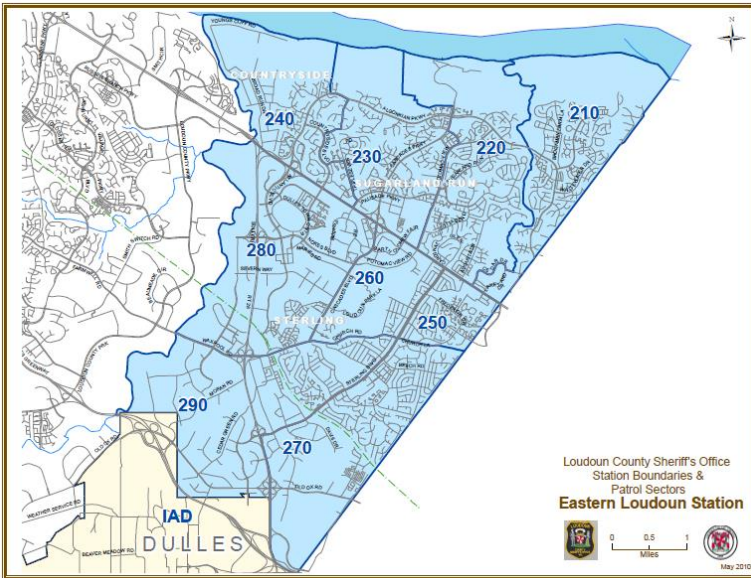

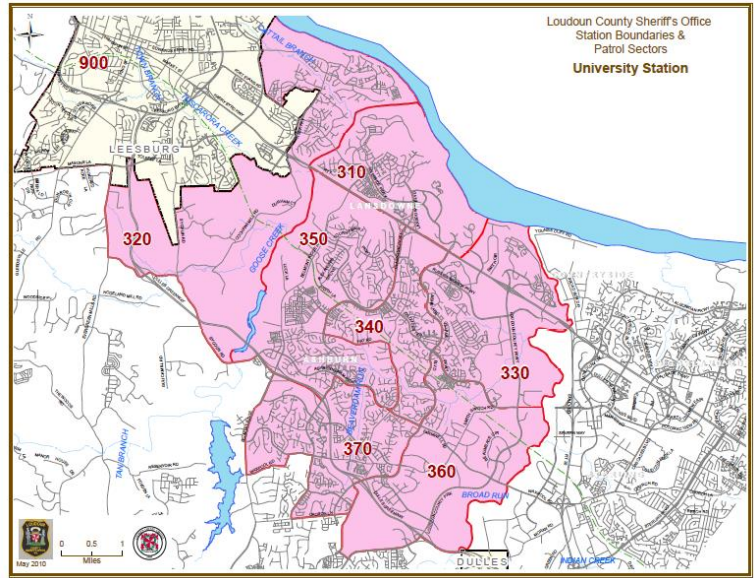

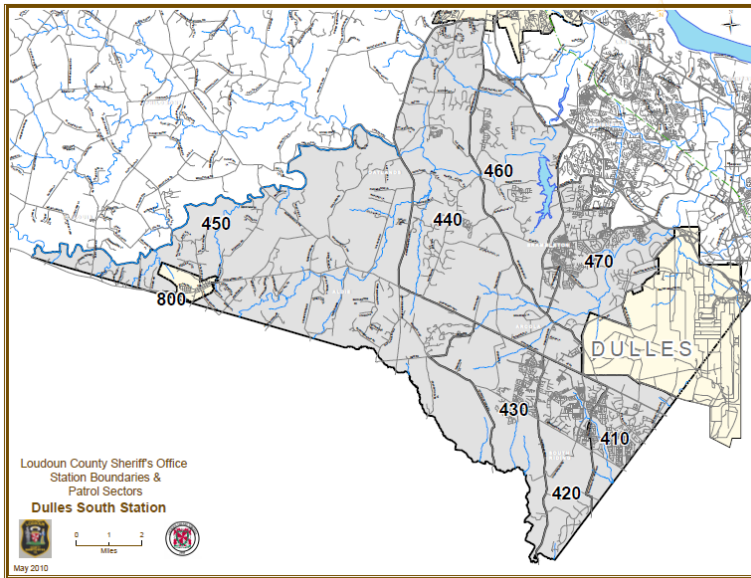
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
