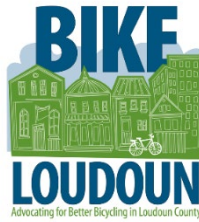

SUPERVISOR BRISKMAN, BIKE LOUDOUN LAUNCH BIKE TO WORK DAY
Group Will Ride from Sterling to Leesburg

Sterling, VA May 11, 2022 — Supervisor Juli Briskman and Bike Loudoun will kick off Bike to Work Day 2022 at Loudoun’s Sterling Pit Stop on May 20 at 7:30 a.m. with a celebration, swag and snacks.

This annual event celebrates a healthy and fun way to get to work, promotes multi-modal transportation options and encourages people to commute by bike with almost 100 different pit stops around Washington, D.C. region.

“I’m excited to celebrate Bike to Work Day with my friends from Bike Loudoun,” Briskman said. “Since the beginning of my term, I have worked hard to support additional infrastructure for bicycles across the county, whether it’s recreational cycling or the last mile to our future metro stations. My office worked with the Department of Transportation and Capital Infrastructure to add bike lanes to a major artery in my district and two more are in the works. Multimodal forms or transportation are good for the environment and good for our health.”
