Purcellville Park & Ride Lot & Commuter Bus Service to the Town of Purcellville Permanently Closes July 3

Due to a Purcellville Town Council Decision to Deny the County's Application to Build a Permanent Park & Ride Lot and Commuter Bus Pickup/Dropoff Location in Purcellville, these services can no longer extend to Purcellville.

Purcellville Park & Ride Lot Closure

Beginning Monday, July 3, commuters who use the existing temporary Park and Ride Lot in Purcellville will be directed five miles east to the Harmony Park and Ride Lot located at 39464 East Colonial Highway, in Hamilton. This 250-space parking lot provides daytime free parking for carpools, vanpools and bus riders as well as bike lockers and EV charging stations.

Purcellville Bus Schedule Changes

Closure of the Park and Ride Lot also results in changes to bus service within the Town of Purcellville. Routes 391, 483, 883, 884 and 885 will pickup and/or dropoff passengers at the Harmony Park and Ride Lot beginning with the morning commute on July 3.

Bus passengers are encouraged to view upcoming bus service adjustments for the impacted routes at loudoun.gov/buschanges. On

July 3, bus service adjustments will begin and new schedules will be posted at loudoun.gov/busschedules.

Please note that the bus stop for Route 40, which is operated by [Virginia Regional Transit \(VRT\)](#), will move to Browning Court just outside the existing temporary Park and Ride Lot in Purcellville. Curb parking will be available.

Background

The existing temporary Park and Ride Lot has occupied the current location owned by Loudoun County Public Schools (LCPS), until a new Park and Ride Lot could be built in Purcellville. The County had set aside funding and planned to build a new Park and Ride Lot within the Town of Purcellville located south of Alder School Road, adjacent to the future Route 7/690 Interchange. However, the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors was forced to cancel this project following a vote by the Purcellville Town Council in March of 2023 to rescind the necessary approvals for the County to construct this new Lot within the Town of Purcellville. Since the County is unable to construct the planned Park and Ride Lot within the Town of Purcellville due to the lack of necessary Town approvals, the project has been cancelled and the existing temporary Park and Ride Lot within the Town will be returned to LCPS for needed LCPS related uses.
