## Planning Commission to Vote on Prime Ag Soils

Dear Catoctin residents,

Many of you have been tracking the proposed prime ag soils zoning amendment, which would place new restrictions on cluster subdivisions in Western Loudoun. The Planning Commission will be considering this proposal at [their work session on Thursday, July 13](#). After that, they will send it to the Board of Supervisors for our consideration.

Thursday is your last chance to tell the Commission what you think about this proposal. I know that is a surprise to some of you, who expected it to be sent to one more Planning Commission public hearing first. It will also be a surprise to others, who aren't used to the Commission allowing public comments at their work sessions.

As it turns out, the Planning Commission has just changed its bylaws in order to follow a last-minute legal change from the General Assembly. From now on, part of the work session agenda will include items that are getting a final vote, and members of the public can sign up to speak about those items.

If you want to speak about the prime ag soils item this Thursday, you can sign up in advance by calling **703-777-0246** or by using their [online signup form](#). The deadline to sign up is noon on Thursday. If you miss the deadline, you can still come to the meeting and speak on a first come, first served basis. Speakers will get 2 minutes to speak, or 4 minutes if they are speaking on behalf of an organization.
