Draft Zoning Ordinance Comes to the Board

Dear Catoctin residents,

Tonight, the Board of Supervisors will be taking a look at the draft zoning ordinance for Loudoun County, which has been sent to us from the Planning Commission. This is a key milestone in the ongoing project to revise and update our zoning ordinance. Due to a prior family commitment, I won't be able to attend tonight's public hearing, but I will be listening to and taking note of the public comments.

The draft ordinance is over 600 pages long, and it covers a host of vital topics, from sign regulation and parking ratios to permitted uses and open space requirements. So tonight's public hearing is just the start of our review process. We will hold a series of work sessions beginning in September, where we will work through the draft ordinance section by section and give each topic the evaluation that it needs.
