LandMARC Launching on August 14



On Monday, August 14th, Loudoun County is launching [LandMARC \(Land Management, Applications, Research, Coordination\)](#), the county's new online land management system. Permitting and land development services are limited until the launch of the new system. Updates to applications, including approval, edits, revisions, or status changes, will not occur until on or after August 14. LandMARC will provide customers and residents with an online portal to submit applications and plans, track the status of applications and projects, and request inspections and pre-meetings, among other items. The system will replace the existing Loudoun Online Land Applications (LOLA) system that is used to search land use applications and submit comments.

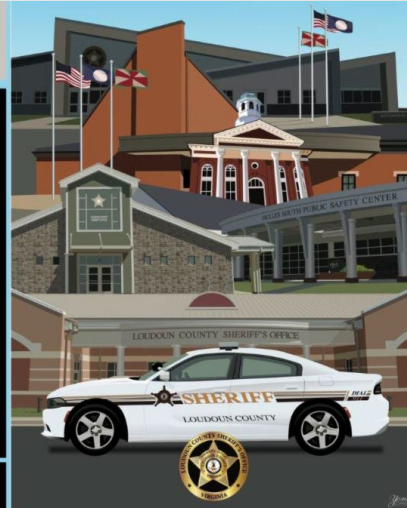
