Loudoun County Parks, Recreation and Community Services (PRCS) will hold the second community workshop on future improvements to Mickie Gordon Memorial Park.

Wednesday, October 4, 2023

6:30 to 8:00 pm

American Legion building, 111 The Plains Road, Middleburg.

The workshop will include a brief presentation of existing conditions and the opportunity for input regarding future recreational elements at the park. Members of the community will participate in group breakout sessions with PRCS staff who will gather input provided by residents on recommended future improvements.

A Special Exception to the county's zoning ordinance previously filed through the county's legislative land use process has been placed on hold to gather further community input regarding future improvements to Mickie Gordon Memorial Park. The Special Exception process allows the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors opportunities to review the request, hear public comment on the

proposal, and impose appropriate conditions or restrictions on the use to minimize any negative impacts.

Mickie Gordon Memorial Park is located at 23229 Carters Farm Lane (Route 627) along Route 50, in Middleburg. The park consists of nearly 100 acres and includes baseball/softball and cricket fields, tennis courts, restrooms, and a pavilion, and offers a fishing pond and free parking. The park also serves as a Loudoun County recycling center.
