Emergency Eviction Assistance Program

EMERGENCY EVICTION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

FOR RESIDENTS ADVERSELY IMPACTED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS MAY APPLY BEGINNING 12:00 P.M., MONDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2023.

Eligible Loudoun County residents may now apply for emergency eviction assistance by submitting an online pre-screening application through the nonprofit Loudoun Cares. The online application is available in English and Spanish, and eligible residents can visit loudouncares.org/eviction to submit an application!

Who is Eligible to Apply for Assistance?

Individuals and families must meet specific criteria to be considered eligible for the eviction assistance program. All applicants must:

- Live in Loudoun County.
- Rent their homes and have a valid current lease.
- Earn less than 80 percent of the Area Median Income.
- Hold a current Eviction Summons (for Unlawful Detainer).
- Be impacted by COVID-19-related economic factors.

As the seasons shift, it's time to prepare your home for changing weather! Heating and cooling are major energy consumers, so now is a great time to weatherize your home to save time and money, and to be more sustainable. Weatherizing reduces the energy we use to make our homes more comfortable by improving moisture control, air sealing, ventilation, and upgrades to insulation, doors and windows.

There are several programs, rebates, and incentives that Loudoun County residents can take advantage of to upgrade their homes, improve comfort and save energy and money:

- **Federal Tax Credits:** Under the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022, federal income tax credits for energy efficiency home improvements will be available through 2032.
