





The crash occurred shortly after 5 a.m. Tuesday morning when a pedestrian was struck by a vehicle in the eastbound lanes of Waxpool Road. The pedestrian was not in a crosswalk at the time of the crash. The driver involved in the crash remained on scene. At this time neither alcohol, drugs, cell phone use, nor speed appear to be factors in the crash. The victim has been identified as Perveen Bilal Bin Butt, 61, of Ashburn. Waxpool Road was closed in both directions between Ashburn Village Boulevard and Regency Drive for nearly four hours.


