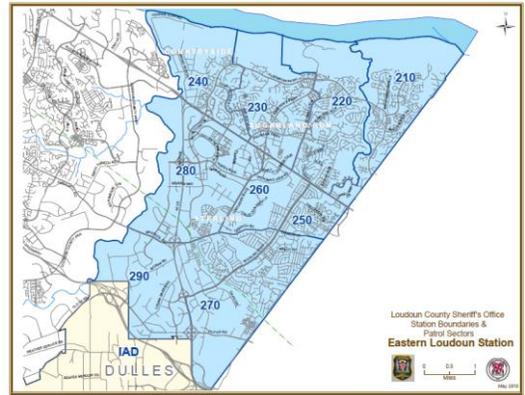
Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Daily Crime Report






