



Ashburn Station



Ashburn	Burglary/Assault/Hit and Run/Driving While Intoxicated: A victim reported that a female and a male, who were known to him, entered his home and assaulted two people. No injuries were sustained by either person. The male suspect stole the homeowner's dog before leaving the residence. The suspects then fled the area in a vehicle. While leaving the scene, the female driver struck a parked car and continued driving. Responding deputies located the suspects driving away from the incident and conducted a traffic stop. The female driver and male passenger were found to be under the influence of alcohol. Taylor R. Davenport, 22, of Ashburn was charged with Burglary, Assault and Battery, Hit and Run, and Driving While Intoxicated. Michael E. Turley, 21, was charged with Burglary, Assault and Battery, Larceny of an Animal, and Public Intoxication. 
