





A male had forced his way into a home and assaulted the homeowner, who was known to him. The homeowner did not sustain any injuries. The suspect was arrested for Domestic Assault and Unlawful Entry. Due to a minor injury the suspect was transported to the hospital. At the hospital the male attempted to run from deputies but was apprehended. While being taken into custody the male assaulted a deputy and attempted to disarm the deputy of his firearm. Nicholas A. Wade, 18, of Hamilton was charged with Domestic Assault, Unlawful Entry, Assault and Battery on Law Enforcement, Attempt to Disarm a Law Enforcement Officer, Obstruction of Justice, and Disorderly Conduct.
