


<p>9/16/2019 0228 hrs.</p>	<p>400 Block West Laurel Ave. Sterling</p>	<p>Burglary: A Sterling man is in custody after he forcibly entered Park View High School shortly before 2:30 a.m. Monday. No one was inside the school at the time of the incident.</p> <p>Gabriel D. Brow, 40, was charged with burglary, trespassing and destruction of property.</p> <p>Loudoun County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 400 block of W. Laurel Avenue in Sterling after they were notified by Safety and Security personnel with Loudoun County Public Schools that there was a burglary in progress at the high school. The suspect could be seen on surveillance video damaging an exterior door to gain entry and heading towards the teacher's lounge inside the school.</p> <p>The suspect was taken into custody without incident by LCSO Deputies with the assistance of a Town of Herndon Police Department K9 unit. The school was searched and no other subjects were located and nothing suspicious was observed. No weapons were found on the suspect.</p> <p>The suspect is being held at the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center pending a bond review when he is sober. SO190017080</p>
<p>9/16/2019 0306 hrs.</p>	<p>Sterling Blvd. / Davis Dr. Sterling</p>	<p>Hit and Run: Deputies responded for reports of a female walking in the roadway on Sterling Boulevard. The female was struck by a vehicle prior to deputies' arrival. The victim sustained serious but non-life-threatening injuries and was transported to the hospital. The striking vehicle fled the scene. Deputies searched the area but were unable to locate the vehicle. Based on evidence located at the scene of the incident, the suspect vehicle is believed to be red in color. Sterling</p>	<p>Robbery: A suspect is in custody and charged in connection with the attempted robbery of a Sterling gas station Friday afternoon. The Leesburg Police Department continues to investigate if the suspect is connected to an attempted robbery that occurred in their jurisdiction at a cash checking store a few hours earlier.</p> <p>The suspect, Jedidiah M. Gauzza, 28, of no fixed address, was identified as the suspect through a joint investigation between the Town of Leesburg Police Department and the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office. The suspect was taken into custody by the Leesburg Police Department Friday evening and held on outstanding capias warrants from Loudoun County and Fairfax County. Additionally, he was charged with attempted robbery and use of a firearm in the commission of a felony by the LCSO in the Sterling robbery, and two counts of identity theft and one count of possession of cocaine by the Leesburg Police Department.</p> <p>The arrest comes after an attempted robbery in Leesburg followed by a second attempted robbery in Sterling on September 13, 2019. The first incident occurred around 11:15 a.m. when the suspect entered Loudoun Checks Cashed in the Town of Leesburg. In that case, the Town of Leesburg Police Department reported the suspect entered the business located in the 20 block of Plaza Street, NE., before fleeing the scene. The second incident occurred shortly after 1 p.m. yesterday, when the suspect entered the Sunoco located on W. Church Road in Sterling, Va., brandished a firearm and demanded cash. There were no reported injuries and nothing was taken during either incident.</p> <p>SO190016919</p>




