Home security cameras are a wonderful investment for your home. There are many affordable makes and models on the market to choose from. Choosing the right system to fit your needs is important.

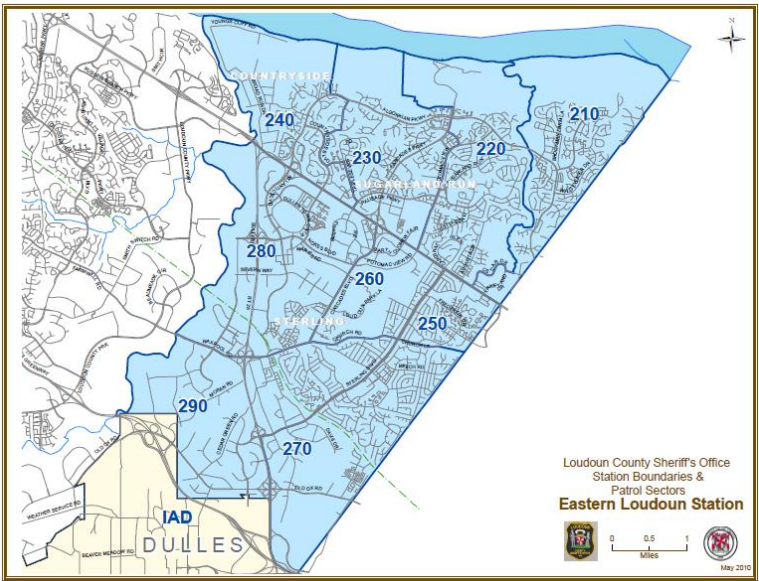
Before purchasing a system, first decide what features are important to you and your family. Some features to consider:



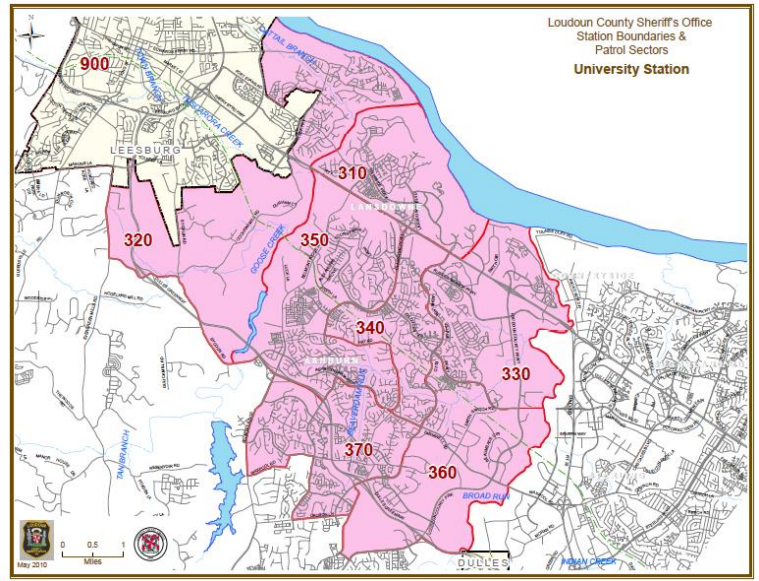
- Cost

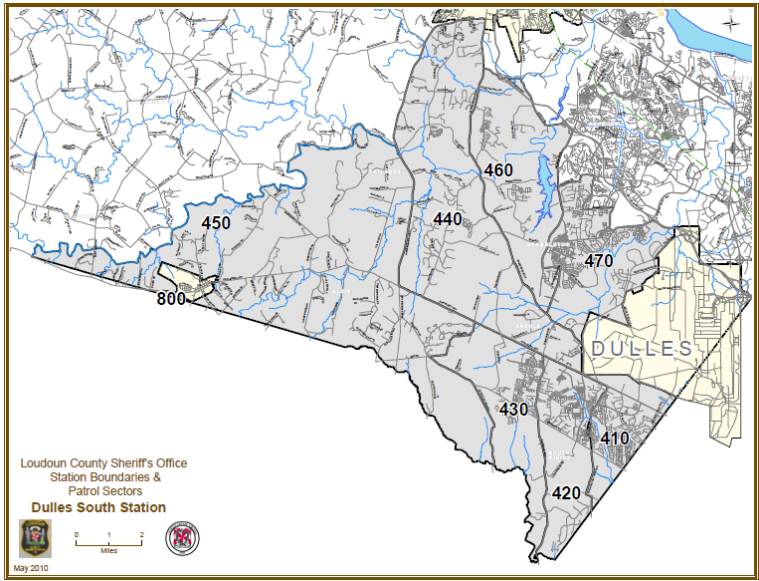
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
