**WHEREAS** The Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), familial status, or disability; and

**WHEREAS** The community and economy are strengthened by inclusion, diversity, equity, and access; and

**WHEREAS** Loudoun County is committed to affirmatively furthering fair housing, removing impediments to fair housing choice, and fostering inclusive communities free from housing discrimination; and


**WHEREAS** Loudoun County is committed to programs that provide attainable housing and educate the public about the right to equal housing opportunities; and
