The League of Women Voters (LWV) is scheduled to provide voter information to members of the public on-site at the Loudoun Workforce Resource Center on October 5th.

LWV staff will assist with:

- Registering to vote (paper application or online)
- Identifying poll locations and early voting sites
- Checking a voter's registration status

- Helping voters identify their federal, state and local legislators
- Understanding how to request an absentee ballot
